

ESL Program

At Spring Street International School, the approach to ESL is through immersion, supported by individual and small group tutorial instruction. Each student is assessed twice per year in writing, grammar, reading and listening, and is placed in classes appropriate to their needs. ESL classes are offered at three levels: Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced.




