

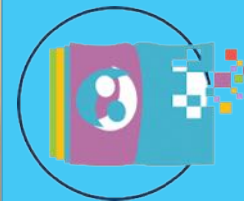

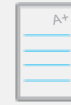

Transition Year

Transition Year offers learners an opportunity to mature and develop without the pressure of an examination. It also provides an opportunity for learners to reflect on, and develop an appreciation of, the value of learning in preparing them for the ever-changing demands of the adult world of work, further and higher education and relationships. Students take classes in the following subjects during the year: Maths, English, History, Geography, French, Design and Communication Graphics, Art, Music, Technical Graphics, Global Business Studies, Craft, World of Work, Ethnic Cookery, Creative Writing, Biology/Chemistry/Physics, Economics. They also undertake work experience, as well as cultural trips and other activities
