Redwood Christian Schools is a highly rated, private Christian school located in San Lorenzo, CA. Redwood offers a rigorous college-prep academic program that prepares students for entrance into top universities. Each course offers opportunities for students to apply content knowledge in various ways through project-based learning. RCA offers 10 AP and Honors classes, 27 electives and all students receive an iPad to be used during the school year.

Redwood offers comprehensive programs in fine arts, which include several selections in visual and performing arts. The Fine Arts Department provides students with the opportunity to explore art, music, and drama, encouraging them to have a sense of confidence through accomplishments in this field. The Visual Arts program is designed as a sequential, experiential journey through the world of line, matter, color, proportion, form and function, texture, and spatial relationships. Students are encouraged to experiment as they increasingly learn technique in the use of graphite pencil, colored pencil, drawing, watercolor painting, calligraphy, and printmaking to create subject matter such as still life, imaginary renderings, animal life, human figure and portraits. 3D projects involve the making of hand built functional and nonfunctional ceramics and paper sculptures. The students will develop skills that will help them analyze their own works of art through the knowledge that is gained during classroom critiques and other activities that include participation in local art contests. In the Drama program students will take an active role in developing their craft through rehearsal with the director, performances for a live audience both inside and outside the classroom, and evaluation of those performances. This may include participation as an actor/ actress and/or participation on a tech crew (set, props, costumes, makeup, sound, lights, marketing). The Music program focuses on melody, harmony, rhythm, tone. Concert Band and Choir are offered at the High School level.

Redwood Christian offers a very competitive athletic program. At the High School level, opportunities are available for both individual and team participation in the following sports: Cross Country (boys and girls), Swimming (boys and girls), Track & Field (boys and girls), Tennis (girls), Volleyball (boys and girls), Soccer (boys and girls), Basketball (boys and girls), Baseball (boys), and Softball (girls).
