The official state dessert of Massachusetts is the Boston cream pie.

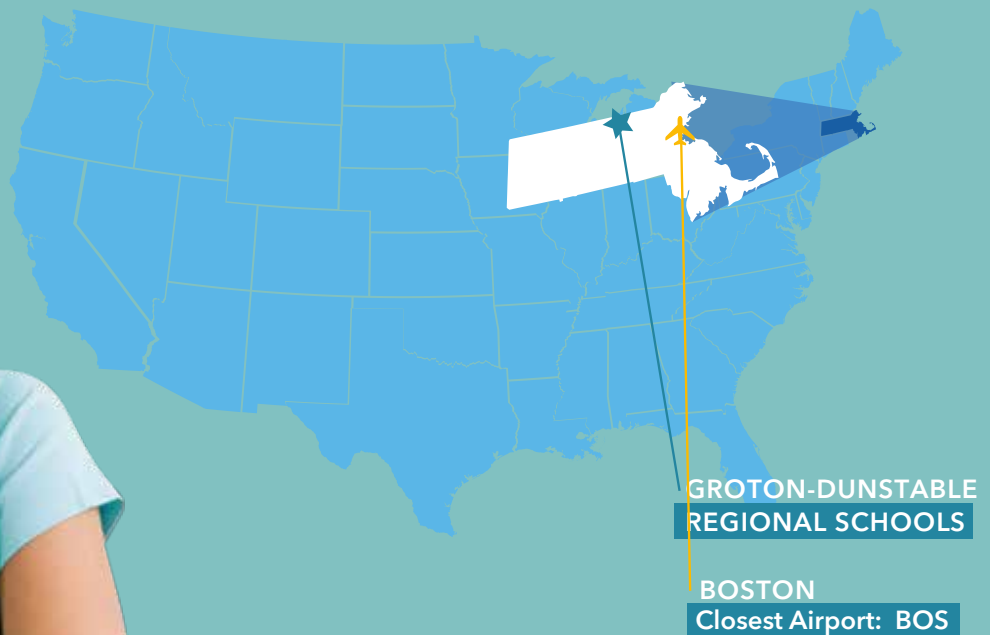
WINTER FUN
