



Glendale is a fast growing suburb of Phoenix, the capital of Arizona. Nearly 4.3 million people live in the Phoenix metropolitan area, with 225,000 of those people living in Glendale. Phoenix is the largest capital city in America, and the sixth largest city by population in the United States.

The Phoenix metropolitan area features thriving arts and culture scene, from unique gardens, centers, and historic areas to world-class museums, such as the Arizona Science Center, Heard Museum, and Frank Lloyd Wright Museum. The Phoenix Metropolitan area has a hot desert climate, with long, extremely hot summers and short, mild winters. Dream City Christian School is a highly rated private Christian school located in the suburbs of Phoenix, AZ. The International Program at DCCS provides personalized attention to each student. The classroom tutoring curriculum focuses on reading, writing, listening, and speaking academic English. Assistance is provided in compulsory course homework, assignments and projects. Special individual attention is given to college entrance essays, college selection, application assistance and other academic guidance and collegiate guidance counseling.

Dream City Christian is considered a big school in regards to the number of sports offered and the level of their players. DCC teams are competitive and each year many participate at the championship level. The school offers great athletic facilities, with most being right on our campus. In addition, student athletes take part in several enrichment activities throughout the year that inter-discipline with athletics; activities such as team building, community service, DCC activities, and Christian motivations. In the IB Diploma Program, 11th and 12th grade students study six courses at both standard level (SL) and high level (HL). Subjects include English, foreign languages, history, the experimental sciences, and mathematics. The sixth subject is an IB elective which often includes the arts. Few students follow the same path, as class selection is tailored to individual student strengths and interests.

The school offers wide range of academic and extracurricular opportunities, including an excellent Arts program. The Performing Arts Department offers both performance and theoretical based classes in Concert Band, Choir, Dance, String Orchestra and IB Music. Members of the school~s performing ensembles perform regularly in festivals, concerts, and competitions. The Media Arts curriculum offers students a full production sequence where they learn film making, editing, directing, and screenwriting.
