



Located in the mid-Willamette Valley, Adair Village is well-situated for those who enjoy outdoor recreation. It is just 6 miles north of Corvallis, 8 miles northwest of Albany, and 12 miles south of Monmouth. Adair Village is a small, safe community of about 1,000 people, but is part of a Benton County which has a population of approximately 87,000 people. This area is about 90 minutes of the Portland Metropolitan area, world class skiing, the spectacular Oregon coast and and there are over 60 miles of biking and hiking trails close by. Neighboring cities of Corvallis and Monmouth are home to two Oregon University System schools, Oregon State University and Western Oregon University respectively. Oregon State University has been ranked by the Princeton Review as one of the top universities in this part of the United States.

Oregon is one of the most geographically diverse states in the US. The state is bordered by Washington in the north, Idaho in the east, Nevada and California in the south, and the Pacific Ocean in the west. The land can be divided into six areas of lowlands, plateaus, and mountains. Oregon is one of only five American states with no sales tax, making it a great place for shopping.

This area falls within the dry-summer temperate climate zone, also referred to as cool-summer Mediterranean. Temperatures are mild year round, with warm, dry, sunny summers and mild, wet winters with persistently overcast skies. Spring and fall are also moist seasons with varied cloudiness, and light rain falling for extended periods. Winter snow is rare, but occasionally does fall, and amounts can range between a dusting and a few inches that do not persist on the ground for more than a day.
