Located on its own 80 acre enclosed campus, Sedbergh Prep School provides pupils aged from 4 to 13 with a safe environment to learn and thrive.

FAQs

When do you accept applications?

Short term immersion is available throughout the academic year subject to availability.

How old does my child need to be?

The immersion courses are available at the Prep School for children aged 8 to 13 (Year 4 to 8) and at the Senior School for children aged 13 to 15 (Years 9 & 10)

Do you provide airport transfers?

Airport transfers are available from Manchester, Liverpool and Leeds/Bradford. Transfers from London Heathrow can be arranged.

How is Sedbergh different to other schools?

Two campuses: Prep School (ages 8-12) and Senior School (ages 13-18). Senior School has 580 full boarders, 7 days a week. Only 13% are international. Nine boarding houses provide in-house dining for a traditional British experience.

What is your nearest airport?

Manchester, 1 hour 30 minutes away. Direct train to London Euston from Oxenholme (2 hours 40 minutes).

What is the application process?

Submit a registration form and recent school report. An interview will be arranged to assess the level of English.
